

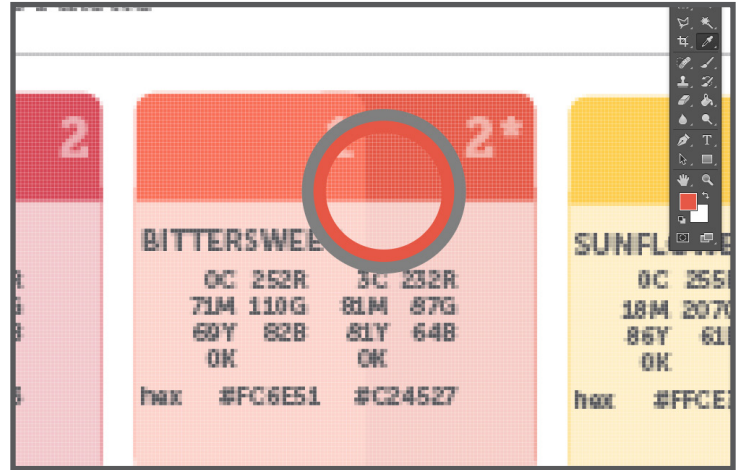
How To:

Find the Pantone color of a CMYK or RGB color in Photoshop

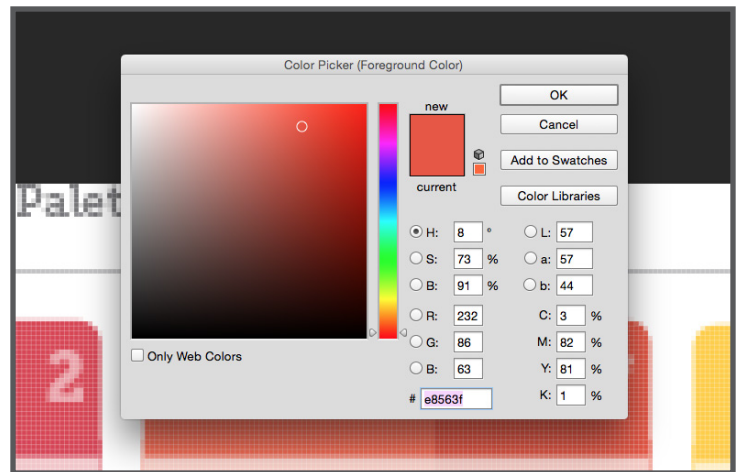
Step 1: Open Photoshop - either open an image that you want to sample color from or copy and paste vector artwork into a Photoshop document.

Step 2: In Photoshop take the image that you want to pull the color from and select that color with the eyedropper tool.

Step 3: When the color appears in the toolbar double click the swatch



Step 4: Click **Color Libraries** in the Color Picker. The color picker will automatically show the settings for Hue Saturation Blend (HSB), Red Green Blue (RGB), Cyan Magenta Yellow Black (CMYK) and hex code.



Step 5: If you haven't done this before you need to select the appropriate color book from the Book dropdown. Pantone: Solid Coated is usually the typical choice. If you are looking for another color book, here is where you select. Color Libraries will open to the closest match color book. Please note, this is the closest match selected by photoshop. You may need to see a Pantone swatch book to be sure the selected color meets your needs.
